So come say hi. Ask us questions. Tell us what you think intelligence really means. We're here for the fun—and for the future we're building together.

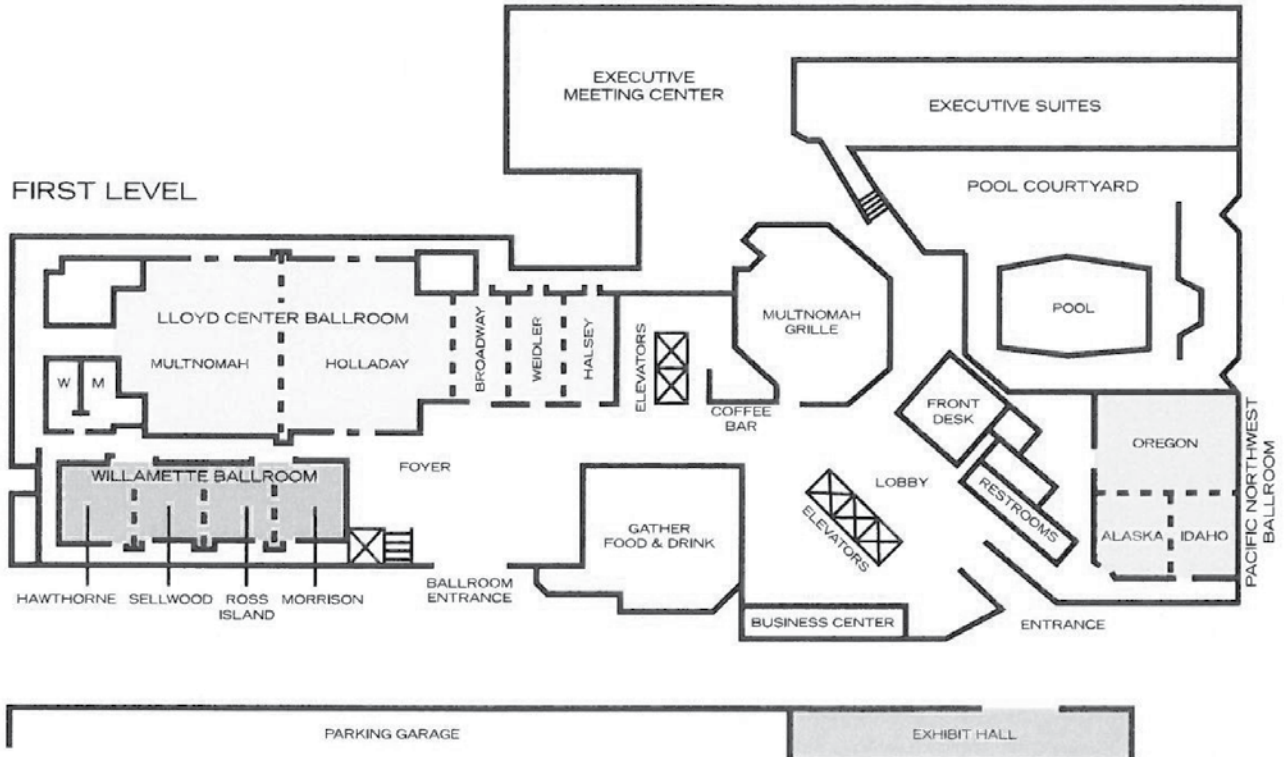

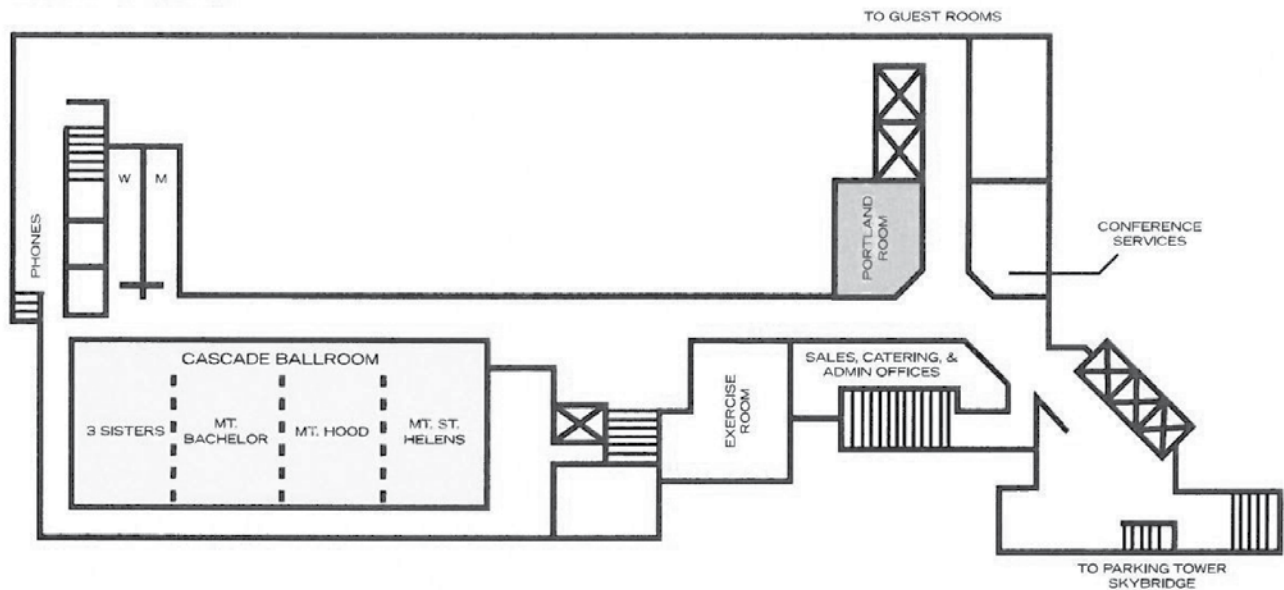

DISCOUNTED BREAKFAST BUFFET OPTION: Hotel Restaurant

FIRST TIMER SESSIONS: 30 games in 3 days? How do we get this thing done? Is there food? When do we sleep? Bring these and other questions to our two First Timer sessions on Thursday. Ziggy will explain how to fill out comment cards and ballots, when and how to vote, finding people to game with, and more!

GAMING HOURS: The games room officially opens on Thursday at 4:00 pm PST. Gaming continues around-the-clock until 5:00 am Sunday morning. Ballots are due by 7:00 am Sunday.

GAME ROOM RULES: Quiet rooms: The smaller game rooms are a place for those who prefer to play in a quieter environment with less external stimulation. Please be respectful in these spaces.

FOOD/ SNACKS: No meals, no messy snacks, all beverages must have lids. We also ask that you do not bring snacks with exposed peanuts or peanut butter into the gaming area, as these oils can linger anywhere touched and are problematic for those with allergies.

INFORMATION ON FILLING OUT COMMENT CARDS:

Players are expected to fill out a comment card for every game they play, regardless of whether the game is on your required list. Non-member guests are also expected to provide feedback on each game, even though they're not voting. Paper comment cards are available on-site. Please return them to the designated location before 7:00 am Sunday morning.

BALLOT INSTRUCTIONS: Ballots are due by 7:00 am Sunday. All member judges will be given a ballot with QR code stickers for each game. You may vote for up to 7 games, ranked first to seventh choices, with first weighted more heavily. Only votes for games on your required list will be counted. Non-member guests may not vote, however, lapsed members have the option to rejoin in time to submit their ballots and get a game in the giveaway.

BADGE RIBBONS

There are a variety of ribbons available to add to your Mind Games badge this year. Here is an overview:

- "First Timer" - Is this your first Mind Games? Wear this badge and others will know to help out/ invite you in!
- "Game On!" - This green ribbon indicates your willingness to play games with others at the event.

3. "Need a Player" indicators will also be available. If you're planning to start a game soon and are open to other players joining, place this on your table. See a "Need a player" indicator on a gaming table next to a game you need to play? Stop by and ask if you can join!
